



International Doping Tests & Management (IDTM)

Doping Control Officer (DCO)

A certified IDTM DCO is an official who has been trained and authorized by IDTM to collect Urine and/ or Blood samples of professional sport athletes. The DCO is at the forefront of IDTM's expert Anti-Doping services to ensure clean and fair play in competition. DCOs are extremely important in protecting the rights of Athletes to compete in drug-free sport.

What are the requirements for a position as an IDTM DCO?

- Twenty-one (21) years of age
- This is not a full time position
- Have a flexible work schedule, assignments are on demand
- Be able to work on short notice
- Fluent in English; ability to communicate strongly
- Be able to follow detailed instructions
- Ability to work under stressful and/or demanding conditions
- Be able to quickly and effectively solve problems
- Always maintain a respectful and professional attitude
- Known as trustworthy and able to maintain strict confidential information
- A valid driver's license and a car is preferred
- Inform IDTM of any possible conflicts of interest (involvement in sport as a coach/doctor/administrator etc., or relations to any athlete that may undergo doping controls)

A **DCO/BCO (Blood Collection Officer)**, in addition to the above, shall at minimum:

- Have a valid and current certification to draw blood
- Collect blood on a regular basis (nurse/doctor/Phlebotomist)
